

## Group I

# General and Personal Competences

*These modules are designed to acquire and/or develop communication, critical and analytical thinking, multilingualism, conflict management, teamwork and other personal competences*

- Team Work (Regina Motienė) LT, R, P.**  
During this module, students will learn how to form a group and a team, allocate functions within a group or team, and resolve issues arising in teamwork.
- Social Psychology (Mindaugas Naudžiūnas) LT, ENG, R, P.**  
This module provides knowledge of social psychology aimed at achieving professional objectives in engineering. It develops cognitive abilities such as a holistic approach to professional decision-making; practical abilities to assess engineering solutions from a social perspective; and transferable skills, including teamwork in multidisciplinary groups, as well as intellectual attitudes such as creativity, innovation and motivation.
- Situation Management Psychology (Mindaugas Naudžiūnas) LT, ENG, R, P.**  
The module introduces the psychology of situation management and patterns of human behaviour, fostering effective communication skills and the practical application of psychological knowledge. The importance of motivation in human behaviour is explained; potential conflict and stress situations are discussed. Preventive psychological aspects of conflict and stress are analysed. Principles of effective communication are presented and developed through practical sessions.
- Sociology (Kęstutis Vitkauskas) LT, ENG, R.**  
This module provides subject-specific knowledge and skills necessary for a systematic understanding of social structure, social change and the significance of the social world for human activity.
- Remedial English (Judita Štreimikienė) LT, ENG, R, P.**  
The module aims to strengthen fundamental English language skills, developing the ability to communicate in English by enhancing all language competences (reading, listening, writing and speaking) and applying them in personal, social and professional contexts.
- German Language for Beginners (Lilija Mieliauskienė) LT, R.**  
The module provides the basics of the German language, developing communication skills in reading, listening, writing and speaking.
- Foreign Language (Lithuanian) (Augustė Urbanavičiūtė) ENG, R.**  
The module introduces learners to the lexical, grammatical and phonetic features of the Lithuanian language, while developing communicative and intercultural competences.
